## Student Performance

Southern Boone School District has received the “Distinction in Performance Award” from the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary for the past seven years. In the 2006-07 school year the district received 100% of the performance points possible.

Southern Boone students score well on the Missouri Assessment Program Tests (MAP). Our students consistently exceed the state average on all assessments. 82.1% of the seniors took the ACT Assessment.

## District Goals

1. Students at Southern Boone Schools will achieve the “High” MAP Performance Index Score on all MAP Assessments.
2. All disaggregated groups will make Adequate Yearly Progress on Communication Arts and Math MAP assessments.
3. The School Board has written long and short range plans for the maintenance, renovation, and replacement of its facilities to accommodate the district’s instructional programs.
4. The At-risk Plan for students in grades K-12 will focus on keeping the dropout rate below 3%.
5. The student attendance percentage at Southern Boone Schools will be at or above 95%.
6. The district will provide resource to support superior student and staff learning through technology.

## Graduation Requirements

A student’s individual academic/career path should be a cooperative plan between the home and school to meet the needs of the student. Students who earn a minimum of thirty-four units of credit according to the following listing are eligible to graduate from Southern Boone County R-1 High School. Requirements for students entering in 2011 and above are:

Language Arts	5	credits
Mathematics	4	credits
Science	3.75	credits
Social Studies	4	credits
(1/2 unit must be Government and 1 unit must be American History)		
Fine Arts	1.5	credits
Practical Arts	3	credits
Physical Education	2	credits
Health	1	credit
Electives	9.75	credits

-Each student must also satisfy specific legal requirements for a high school diploma. No more than 2 credits may be earned in a summer school or correspondence course offered outside the Southern Boone district. The two credits must be classes that were failed previously.  
-Each student must have passed the Missouri Constitution Test and the United States Constitution Test prior to graduation from high school.

## Extracurricular Activities

A variety of extracurricular activities are available for students at Southern Boone Schools. These include clubs and organizations such as game, science, Future Farmers of America (FFA), Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA), band, choir and cheerleading. Competitive activities include: Quiz Bowl, baseball, softball, basketball, football, soccer, golf, cross country, track, and volleyball.
