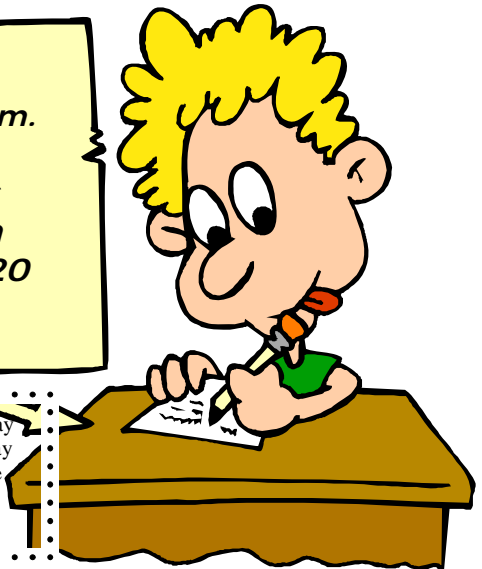

### IF YOUR CHILD IS ABSENT

Regular attendance in school is vital to your child's success in school. However, when your child is absent, please take the following steps:

- Parent or legal guardian should phone the school office before 9:00 on the day of the absence.
- Ask teacher for make-up assignments.
- If the absence is due to work, travel, or some other reason, please contact the school prior to the absence to make arrangements for your child's work.

### IF YOUR CHILD IS ILL

If your child is ill, and cannot attend school, follow the directions above. Students should not be sent to school if they have a fever or a contagious illness. If your child becomes sick at school, you will be contacted immediately and be asked to come and pick your child up. Please keep all emergency phone numbers updated throughout the year if there are changes.



## School Lunches

Students may bring their lunch or purchase a school lunch. Breakfast is also available. Please deposit enough money into your child's account regularly to keep it up to date. Make checks payable to Southern Boone County School District.

## Lost and Found

Clothing and other items should be clearly marked with the child's name. Articles found in and around school will be turned into the main office where they may be claimed.

## Bus Conduct Policy

In order to insure the safety of every student who rides a school bus at Southern Boone County School, the following policy will be in effect.

1. At the beginning of each year, and periodically throughout the year, bus rules will be discussed with students.
2. When misbehavior occurs, a bus conduct notice will be written. This notice will be given to the school administration. The parent will be notified of this warning.
3. The second time the driver issues a written conduct notice for the same student, the student will be suspended from riding the bus for three days. The parents will be notified of this suspension by phone and/or mail.
4. Subsequent written conduct notices will increase the suspension time to 5 days for the third violation and 10 days for fourth and future violations.

Summary: FIRST OFFENSE: Warning

SECOND OFFENSE: 3-day suspension from the bus

THIRD OFFENSE: 5-day suspension from the bus

FOURTH OFFENSE: 10-day suspension from the bus

NOTE: Serious conduct violations may result in immediate suspension.

The following are examples of specific regulations that are in effect:

1. THE DRIVER IS IN CHARGE OF THE PUPILS AND THE BUS. PUPILS MUST OBEY THE DRIVER PROMPTLY.
2. Students must be waiting at the bus stop. The bus cannot wait for those students who are tardy.
3. The driver shall not pick up or discharge riders at places other than their regular bus stop unless authorized by parents and the school administration.
4. Students are to be sitting at all times when the bus is in motion.
5. Students must not at any time extend arms or heads out of windows.
6. Tape recorders, cd players, walkmans, radios, skateboards and jam boxes are not to be brought to school on the bus.
7. Pupils are not to use tobacco products at any time on the bus.
8. No animals (wild or tame) are permitted on the bus.
9. Fighting and profanity will not be allowed and may result in immediate suspension.
10. Anyone having a cutting instrument out of his/her pocket or purse, open or closed, on the bus will be suspended from riding the bus.
11. Any damage to a bus by a student must be paid for by the pupil responsible for the damage.
12. While traveling on a school bus, children are expected to maintain order, and they are subject to the directions and orders of the driver just as they are subject to the discipline of their teachers while in the classroom.
13. No consumption of food or drink will be allowed on the bus.

### Students Assigned to Buses

Due to the number of students riding school buses, students will not be able to have friends ride the bus with them. Parents will have to provide transportation for sleepovers, etc.
